The East Birmingham Renewal Group Trust was set up in 1984

This was the time that Roger Jones went into full time Christian music ministry and the trust was set up initially in order to raise funds to support his ministry.

About the trust

- The trust exists to give financial support for the ministry of Christian musicians.
- Currently regular monthly grants are paid to Roger Jones to enable him, through Christian Music Ministries, to employ such staff as are needed to fulfil the itinerant Christian music ministry.
- Since 1994 Annie Routley has been employed to work alongside Roger in the ministry. Annie now leads many events herself.
- On occasions, grants are also paid to other musicians and organisations that are working in line with the aims of EBRG Trust.

The trustees

There are currently seven EBRG trustees who meet regularly to monitor the progress and direction of the ministry, and to review the ongoing financial situation. They are:

Funding the trust

The trust is funded by several sources:

- One-off gifts and donations from individuals.
- Regular monthly or annual gifts.
- Gifts from churches and organisations that invite Roger Jones and a team from CMM to lead workshops, seminars and other events.
