This autumn we are delighted to be able to launch a new musical, 'Three Wise Camels'.

On a visit to see my wonderful friends, Jane and George Hicks, on the south coast, I saw a copy of a small playlet Jane had written. I thought to myself, 'This would make a good musical' but it went no further. Then, as lockdown began, I started to compose, and with lyric assistance from both Jane Hicks and Alison Fuggle, as well as wonderful illustrations from George, a musical containing eight songs has been brought to birth!



Jane's play features three camels, Camelia, Humphrey and Samson as they set out on what proves to be the most exciting journey of their lives! Seen through the camels' eyes, the musical reveals truths about the costly gifts of the Three Kings as they follow the extrabright star, which guides them along their way to Bethlehem. There, to their amazement, they discover that the gifts are for a little boy.

Backing tracks were created by Tim Jones, Chris King and Annie Routley, and the recording was made in a socially-distanced way. Some instrumental work was recorded remotely, and the backing vocals were completed by a very small group. The recording also features three wonderful CMM soloists, Jennifer Douglas, Simon Gudger and Bob Deakin.









A special feature of this album is a full recording of the drama, made by James Barron (Humphrey), Jane Hicks (Camelia) and Dave Green (Sampson). This musical really will appeal to children and adults alike, and it is our prayer that it will bring life and light to many.
